Police recover over ₹43L in digital arrest scam case

The cyber crime police successfully cracked a cyber fraud case amounting ₹1.55 crore through “digital arrest” and recovered ₹43,14,024 which was returned to the victim on Thursday. The victim, a resident of Hazratganj, fell prey to cyber criminals posing as officers of Anti-Terrorism Squad based in Pune, Maharashtra. The scammers used intimidation tactics, falsely claiming that the victim’s Aadhaar card was linked to illegal and terrorist activities. They held the victim under digital arrest and coerced her into transferring ₹1.55 crore to multiple bank accounts. The funds were initially routed through four separate accounts in Kerala, Karnataka, Gautam Buddha Nagar and Maharashtra. From there, the money was moved into a bank account in Gurugram and subsequently split in 300 accounts tied to fake gaming apps and payout settlement websites. The Lucknow cyber crime team worked in sync with various banks and financial channels. Their swift intervention led to the immediate freezing of all fraudulent accounts involved in the network. Out of the ₹1.55 crore swindled, the police successfully secured and returned ₹43,14,024 to the victim. The police are to trace the remaining amount, and identify and arrest the absconding culprits. Expressing gratitude, the victim thanked the Lucknow police, saying their rapid response restored her hope for justice. To prevent similar incidents, the Lucknow Police have clarified that the government and law enforcement agencies never conduct arrests or investigations via video calls and so people should not panic if they receive such threats. The people have been asked to never share their mobile, internet banking, or UPI credentials with strangers and not to download unknown APK files, click on unverified links, or engage with fraudulent gaming apps. “If you experience cyber fraud or suspect your phone has been compromised, immediately call the National Cyber Crime Helpline at 1930 or visit www.cybercrime.gov.in to register a complaint,” the police appealed to the public.

2 nabbed for stealing chain
The Thakurganj police, in a joint operation with the DCP West zone surveillance team, have arrested two women for allegedly stealing a gold chain from an elderly woman travelling in an e-rickshaw. The arrested accused reside in the slum area near the Dewa Sharif dargah in the Barabanki and share a history of prior involvement in theft-related cases. According to police, the incident occurred on August 28. The victim, a resident of Aliganj, was travelling in an e-rickshaw from Rumi Gate towards Dubagga with her son. The two accused women boarded the same e-rickshaw near the Balaganj crossing and committed the crime taking advantage of the rush. Following a complaint filed by the victim on Wednesday, the Thakurganj police registered a case under relevant sections of the Bharatiya Nyaya Sanhita (BNS). Wanted suspect arrested in LDA property fraud case

The Crime Branch of the Lucknow police has arrested a wanted suspect, Sachin Singh, who had been evading law enforcement for nearly four years in connection with a major Lucknow Development Authority (LDA) property fraud case, the police said on Thursday. The arrest was made on September 1 around 5:20 pm near the Indian Oil petrol pump in Chhoti Bharwara, Gomti Nagar Extension, by a specialised team from the Economic Offences Wing (EOW) of the Crime Branch. The case dates back to an FIR registered at the Gomti Nagar police station under various sections of the Indian Penal Code (IPC) concerning cheating, forgery and criminal conspiracy. According to the investigation, the syndicate fabricated forged and fake documents for an LDA plot in Viraj Khand, Gomti Nagar, measuring 1,250 square feet. Police revealed that the fraudsters first created fraudulent digital records on the LDA portal in the name of a woman. Using these manipulated papers, the property was subsequently sold to another woman, who later transferred and sold it for Rs 35 lakh to a third woman. The sale proceeds were initially received in a woman’s bank account and a share of the profits was funnelled directly into the bank account of Sachin Singh, exposing his role in the criminal conspiracy. Following his implication, Sachin Singh went into hiding to evade arrest. Investigations uncovered that he previously managed a hotel in Vibhuti Khand, Gomti Nagar, which served as a planning hub where the accused conspired to draft fake documents. Once law enforcement closed in, he fled the city and had recently been operating a fish-farming business after securing a dam contract in Lalitpur. Through continuous technical surveillance, tracking, and human intelligence networks, the EOW traced his movements, leading to his successful apprehension. Out of the five individuals implicated in this sprawling fraud ring, three have already been arrested and charge-sheeted, one accused has passed away and the final wanted fugitive, Sachin Singh, has now been captured. A background check on the accused revealed a history of serious offences. In addition to the current LDA property fraud case, Sachin Singh has prior criminal cases registered against him, including a major counterfeited currency case under sections related to Fake Indian Currency Notes (FICN) at the Naka police station, as well as a cheating and breach of trust case at the Vibhuti Khand police station. Police said that the crackdown on organised syndicates manipulating LDA properties remains a top priority and that further systemic checks will continue.

Man drowns
A body of a 35-year-old man who had drowned in a village pond under the Kakori police station on Wednesday was recovered on Thursday. The victim, identified as Bablu Yadav (35) and a permanent resident of Rewari village under the Kakori police station, had gone to the village pond on Wednesday. According to eyewitness accounts and preliminary police reports, the man attempted to swim across the open body of water. However, halfway in the pond, he encountered difficulties, struggled against the water currents or fatigue, and tragically went under water, failing to resurface. On receiving information, a team of officers from the Kakori police station rushed to the spot. The police coordinated with specialised disaster management units. The rescue operation had to be temporarily suspended for the night for safety reasons. The search operation resumed on Thursday. Following hours of coordinated efforts by the divers and emergency personnel, the body of Bablu Yadav was successfully retrieved from the pond.
